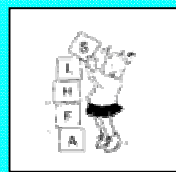




EDUPLAY NEWSLETTER SEPTEMBER 2009

Eduplay have become the proud new owners of The Funky Fun Bus!!

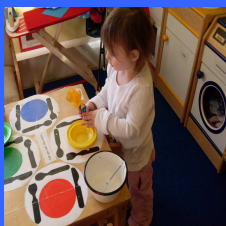

Play And Party Hosts

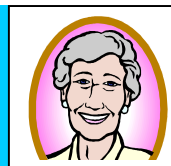
We are always on the lookout for enthusiastic, fun and energetic sessional staff to work on a flexible basis to facilitate play and party activities aboard our funky fun bus!
